NOTIFICATION

GSR\_\_\_\_\_ In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Deputy Director (Hindi) Recruitment Rules, 1995 namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Deputy Director (Hindi) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2003.
- (4) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. For the Schedule to the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Deputy Director (Hindi) Recruitment Rules, 1995, following schedule shall be substituted, namely:-

**Deputation:**

Officers of the Central Government: -

- (a)(i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or
- (ii) with five years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the scale of Rs. 8000-13500 or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; or
- (iii) with six years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of Rs. 7500-12000 or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; or
- (iv) with eight years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of Rs. 6500-10500 or equivalent in the parent cadre/Department; and
- (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:-

Essential:-

- (i) Master's Degree of a recognised University or equivalent in Hindi with English as a subject at the Degree level;
- or
- Master's Degree of a recognised University or equivalent in English with Hindi as a subject at the Degree level;
- Or
- Master's Degree of a recognised University or equivalent in any subject with Hindi and English as a subject at the Degree level;
- Or
- Master's Degree of a recognised University or equivalent in any subject with Hindi medium and English as a subject at the Degree level;
- Or
- Master's Degree of a recognized University or equivalent in any subject with English medium and Hindi as a subject at the Degree level; and
- (ii) Five year's experience of terminological work in Hindi or translation

work from English to Hindi or vice-versa, preferably of technical or scientific literature.

Or

Five year's experience of teaching, research, writing or journalism in Hindi (Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding the appointment in the same or some other organisation/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three(3) years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years, as on the closing date of receipt of applications).
