G.S.R.....In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Deputy Director(Legal) Recruitment Rules, 1997, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Deputy Director (Legal) Recruitment(Amendment) Rules,2001.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Deputy Director (Legal) Recruitment Rules, 1997, for the Schedule, following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:-



NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.....In exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution, the President after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, hereby makes the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Director (Legal) in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, namely:-

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT (1). These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, Deputy Director (Legal) Recruitment Rules, 1997.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. NUMBER OF POSTS, CLASSIFICATION AND SCALE OF PAY
The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT, QUALIFICATION ETC. The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

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4. DISQUALIFICATION : No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Comptroller and Auditor General of India may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. POWER TO RELAX Where the Central Government, on the request of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.

6. SAVING Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government, in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, from time to time, in this regard.
