

G.O.R. 1154 - In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, the President hereby makes the following rules, to regulate the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Auditor in the field offices of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Senior Auditor) Recruitment Rules, 1985.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.- The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications.- No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said post :

Provided that the Comptroller and Auditor General of India may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

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5. Power to relax.- Where the Comptroller and Auditor General of India is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of India from time to time in this regard as applicable to persons employed in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department.

(1) Senior Auditors from any other Audit Office; or

- 1. Senior Deputy Accountant General or Deputy Accountant General or Officer of equivalent rank in charge of administration group.
- 2. Any other Senior Deputy Accountant General or Deputy Accountant General or Officer of equivalent rank.
- 3. One Senior Audit Officer.

(1i) Auditors from any other Audit Office, with three years' regular service in the grade and who have passed departmental examination for auditors. (Period of deputation shall ordinarily not exceed three years).

सा.का.नि. 573.—राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 148 के खंड (5) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए और भारत के नियंत्रक-महालेखा परीक्षक से परामर्श करने के पश्चात् भारतीय लेखापरीक्षा तथा लेखा विभाग (ज्येष्ठ-लेखा परीक्षक) भर्ती नियम, 1985 का संशोधन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात् :—

1. (1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम भारतीय लेखापरीक्षा तथा लेखा विभाग (ज्येष्ठ-लेखा परीक्षक) भर्ती (संशोधन) नियम, 1990 है।

(2) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2. भारतीय लेखापरीक्षा तथा लेखा विभाग (ज्येष्ठ-लेखापरीक्षक भर्ती नियम, 1985 में ;

(i) नियम 6 में "अनुसूचित जनजातियों और अन्य विशेष प्रवर्ग के व्यक्तियों" शब्दों के स्थान पर, "अनुसूचित जनजातियों भूतपूर्व सैनिकों और अन्य विशेष प्रवर्ग के व्यक्तियों" शब्द रखे जाएंगे।

(ii) अनुसूची में ;

(क) स्तम्भ 2 में विद्यमान प्रविष्टि के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित प्रविष्टि रखी जाएगी, अर्थात् :—

"13579" (1990)

"कार्यभार के आधार पर परिवर्तन किया जा सकता है ;

(ख) स्तम्भ 4 में विद्यमान प्रविष्टि के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित प्रविष्टि रखी जाएगी, अर्थात् :—

"1400-40-1600-50-2300 द.रो.-60-2600 इ

(ग) स्तम्भ 10 में विद्यमान प्रविष्टि के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित प्रविष्टि रखी जाएगी, अर्थात् :—

"लागू नहीं होंगे—

(घ) स्तम्भ 12 में विद्यमान प्रविष्टि के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित प्रविष्टि रखी जाएगी, अर्थात् :—

"प्रोन्नति :—

1200-2040 के बतनमान में ऐसे लेखापरीक्षक जिन्होंने उस श्रेणी में 3 वर्ष नियमित सेवा की है और लेखापरीक्षकों के लिए विभागीय परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण कर ली है।

प्रतिनियुक्ति पर स्थानांतरण :

भारतीय लेखापरीक्षा और लेखा विभाग के अन्य क्षेत्र कार्यालयों में :—

(i) ज्येष्ठ लेखापरीक्षक/ज्येष्ठ लेखाकार, या

(ii) ऐसे लेखापरीक्षक/लेखाकार जिन्होंने श्रेणी में तीन वर्ष नियमित सेवा की है और लेखापरीक्षकों/लेखाकारों के लिए विभागीय परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण कर ली है।

(पोपक प्रवर्ग के ऐसे विभागीय अधिकारी जो प्रोन्नति की सीढ़ी पंक्ति में हैं; प्रतिनियुक्ति पर नियुक्ति के लिए विचार किए जाने के पात्र नहीं होंगे। इसी प्रकार प्रतिनियुक्ति व्यक्ति प्रोन्नति द्वारा नियुक्ति के लिए विचार किए जाने के पात्र नहीं होंगे। प्रतिनियुक्ति की अवधि जिसके अंतर्गत केन्द्रीय सरकार के उसी या किसी अन्य संगठन विभाग में इस नियुक्ति से ठीक पहले अन्य संगठन विभाग में इस नियुक्ति के ठीक पहले भारत किसी अन्य काठर बाह्य पद पर नियुक्ति की अवधि है, साधारणतया तीन वर्ष से अधिक नहीं होगी।

टिप्पण:

(1) यदि किसी अधिकारी की प्रोन्नति पर विचार किया जाते हैं तो उससे ज्येष्ठ सभी व्यक्तियों पर भी विचार किया जाएगा (यदि उन्होंने, जहां लागू हो, प्रवीक्षा पूरी कर ली है), इस बात के हाने पर भी कि उन्होंने लेखापरीक्षक के रूप में अपेक्षित सेवावधि पूरी नहीं की है।

(2) ज्येष्ठ लेखापरीक्षक के काठर और लेखापरीक्षक के पोपक काठरों का समस्त विभाग के लिए केन्द्रीयकरण का कारण ये नियम विभाग के विभिन्न क्षेत्र कार्यालयों के प्रत्येक काठर को लागू हैं। प्रोन्नति के लिए प्रयोजित सेवावधि संबंध क्षेत्र कार्यालय में होनी चाहिए।

(इ) स्तम्भ 13 में, मद सं. 2 के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित रखा जाएगा; अर्थात् :—

2. ज्येष्ठ उप महालेखाकार/उप महालेखाकार या समतुल्य पंक्ति का अधिकारी (उस कार्यालय से भिन्न कार्यालय से जिसमें प्रोन्नति के लिए विचार किया जा रहा है)।

G.S.R. 573.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Senior Auditor) Recruitment Rules, 1985, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Senior Auditor) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1990.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. In the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Senior Auditor) Recruitment Rules, 1985,—

(i) in rule 6, for the words "Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons", the words "Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons" shall be substituted;

(ii) in the Schedule,—

(a) in item 2, for the existing entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :—

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"subject to variation dependent on workload."

(b) in column 4, for the existing entry, the following entry shall be substituted namely :—

"Rs. 1400-40-1600E-50-2300-1 B-60-2600";

(c) in column 10, for the existing entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :—  
"Not applicable";

(d) in column 12, for the existing entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :—

"Promotion :

Auditors in the grade of Rs. 1200-2040 with three years regular service in that grade, having passed Departmental Examination for Auditors.

Transfer on deputation :

From other field offices in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department:—

(i) Senior Auditors, Senior Accountants, or

(ii) Auditors, Accountants with three years regular service in the grade, having passed the Departmental Examination for Auditors, Accountants.

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation, experiment of the Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years).

Note :

(1) If an officer is considered for promotion, all persons senior to him shall also be considered (if they have completed the probation, where applicable) notwithstanding that they have not rendered the requisite period of service as Auditor.

(2) As the cadre of Senior Auditor and feeder cadre of Auditor are not centralised for the entire department, the rules are applicable to each cadre in the various field offices of the department. The requisite period of service prescribed for promotion shall be in the field office concerned."

(e) in column 13 for item 2, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

2. Senior Deputy Accountant General, Deputy Accountant General or an officer of equivalent rank (from an office other than the office in which promotions are considered)."
